Mrs Jane Walker Chair of Governors	Jane has a long association with the school, having joined as a Governor in 2012. She became Chair of Governors in 2018. Jane is a retired NHS Physiologist. Jane is our Lead Governor for Looked-after Children (LAC) and Safeguarding.
Mrs Sally Baker Vice Chair of Governors	Sally joined the governing body in 2018. Sally is the manager for a chain of Children's nurseries and has previously run her own nursery. Before joining the Governing Body, she worked at Bluebell Wood Children's Hospice. Sally took on the role of Vice Chair in 2021 and also serves as Lead Governor for Foundation Stage, Health and Safety and Governor training and development.
Mrs Stephanie (Steph) Parmenter	Steph joined the Governing Body in October 2020. She is a qualified teacher of Performing Arts and PE and works in Mansfield. Steph's specialisms are Dance, Drama, Art and Music. She has recently taken on the role of Lead Governor for Pupil Premium.

Mrs Jeanette Adams	Jeanette is a Staff Governor, elected by her teaching colleagues. She is an experienced member of staff who has worked in both KS1 and KS2, allowing her to bring a unique perspective to the Governing Body.
