## Free School Meals - are you eligible?

The last two years have taken a financial toll on many families across the country. If your financial situation has changed recently, your child may be eligible for Free School Meals. Very often, families with children in the infants don't apply for Free School Meals, because all infants are automatically eligible for free dinners. But did you know that accessing Free School Meals also entitles your child to the Pupil Premium? This means that the government gives us money to spend on improving provision for your child. If you'd like to chat about this, please don't hesitate to give us a call in school.
