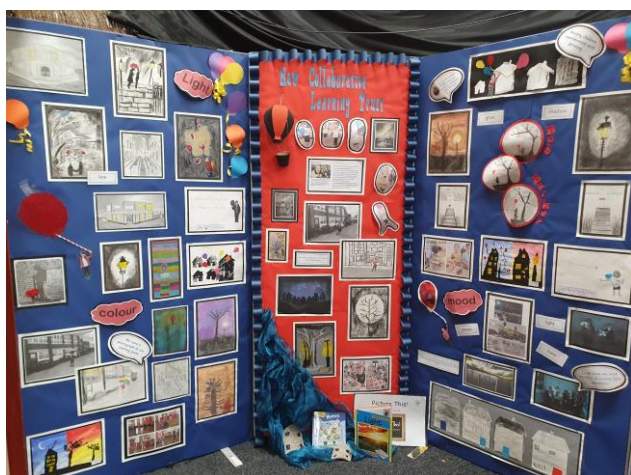
Dinner Money
