# Spooky Disco

The PTA are excited to invite the children to a Spooky Disco on the evening of Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> October – the last day for children before half term. More info will follow from the PTA. Please note: although the school day will be non-uniform (as it always is on the last day before the holidays), spooky costumes may be worn in the evening only. Last year, we invited children to wear costumes all day, but hindsight tells us this was not our best idea!

#### Doodle

Big news! We are delighted to let you know that our PTA have funded a whole-school subscription to Doodle Maths. We're confident you're going to love this as much as we do in school. Doodle is a school and homework programme that children complete on a tablet etc. After completing a baseline task in school, the software automatically sets children a series of quick questions which they can access each day (their "Daily Doodle") to reinforce the learning they do in their maths



lessons. The children are rewarded for their work with stars that they can use to develop their in-game avatar. The really clever part is that the questions change over time to match the strengths of each child and the areas they need a little more work on. You can even make a parent log-in so that you can keep a track of your child's progress, just as we can in school. Keep a look-out for your child's login details, which will be sent to you in the coming weeks, after all the baselines have been completed.

#### Lockdown Drill

Today, the children took part in a 'lockdown drill', so you may find that your child wants to talk to you about this (unless they're like mine and only ever say they've done "nothing" or "stuff"!) As you know, primary children are now expected to do this occasionally, in line with national guidance. These work in a similar way to fire drills, but with a different response from staff and children. In the juniors, we talk to the children sensitively and reassuringly about why we do lockdown drills. In the infants, the children see this as a game. All the children did very well with it today.

## Drop-off and Pick-up

We've had requests from a few parents to mention the congestion around school, with adults congregating by the fence in such a way that children need to walk onto the road to pass. Please be mindful of this during drop-off and pick-up. Thank you very much for your support with this.
