Staffing News

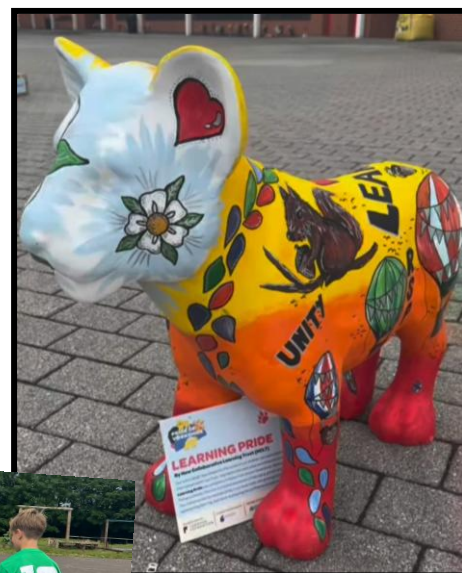


Non-Uniform Day for Tombola
